



Christmas Tree

Safety checklist

- 1 Choose a tree with fresh, green needles that do not fall off when touched.



- 2 Make sure the tree is at least 3 feet away from any heat source, like fireplaces, radiators, candles, heat vents or lights.



- 3 Place the tree away from heat sources. Make sure the tree is not blocking an exit.

RIGHT ✓



- 4 Water your Christmas tree every day
A dry tree can catch on fire easily

RIGHT ✓



- 5 Use lights that are listed by a qualified testing laboratory. Pay attention to indoor/outdoor use.

WARNING!

Damaged decor lights may cause fire and electric shock!

- 8 Don't overload your sockets!
Do not use more than 3 light strands in a row



- 6 Check your decor for damage and replace as needed

- 7 Turn off your lights before bed or while you are away from home
